Amateur All-Age

The amateur all age championship was a competitive 12 dog stake with half the field getting around clean.

Our champion came from brace 4B with Lewey/Blum. Lewey ran a very mature all age race. Lewey had multiple finds at 19, 23, 36 and the 48 minute mark. Lewey demonstrated great style with impeccable manners. His finds were all to the front and on the limb.

Amateur Shooting Dog

Our Champion is Lena – Cuttin Wild’s Space Cowgirl-owned and handled by Mike Patrick. She performed in brace 9B on the second day of the event.

Her excellent forward race throughout the course provided multiple big moves to the front. Find #1 @ 7 minutes was a nice edge find, very stylish and solid. Find #2 @ 33 was classy and with great location. At 49, she was once again was on a nice line move to this find. At 53, digging through the ‘airport narrows’ she was found buried in cover, again everything in perfect order. She completed the hour strong and forward. One judge noted “she just had those kind of moves that made me say, WOW

The stake broke away the morning of February 10th 2020. The weather was rainy and cool and making the ground was muddy. The Champion was Cuttin Wild's Rebel Yell (Rebel) and the Runner up was Quijano's WD Forty Rusty (Rusty).

Brace #1

Tex Bourbon Street Strutter (SatchMo), owned and handled by David O'Brien. Satch had 3 nice finds with a smaller shooting dog race. Snowy River's Cuttin Country (Dozer) Owned by Mark & Chase Verdoorn, handled by Chase Verdoorn was lost from the breakaway.

There were thunderstorms and torrential rain during the morning. The Judges were Mike Griffin and Jon Small. There were 17 dogs drawn and 17 dogs broke away. The grounds were saturated and super muddy from all the rainfall. Running All Age dogs on

such a muddy grounds made for an interesting stake. If the dog did not go to the front and point birds and hold them, then most were lost or coming from behind as the scouts were handicapped by the riding conditions.

The Champion was Llano's Snowbird (Feather), owned by Joe and Chad Inderman, handled by Josh Neiman. Feather ran as a bye dog the last brace of the stake. Feather has a nice flowing forward race with numerous finds.

The Runner-up Champion was Texas Tuff, Owned by Terry Bomer, handled by Keith Gullede and scouted by Robbi Gullede. Tuff has 4 evenly spaced finds. Broke away, was found standing to the front at 8, turned loose & found standing at 25, again at 40 and the last time at 50. Owned by Terry Bomer, handled by Keith Gullede.

The NGSPA Region VII Open Shooting Dog was judged by Ed Tillson and Mike Griffin. We drew 24 dogs and broke away 24 dogs. Again the grounds were muddy, but the rain held off the rest of the stake.

The Champion and Runner Up ran in Brace 7 with Cuttin Wild's Space Cowgirl (Lena), owned by Mike Patrick and handled by Josh Nieman, scouted by David Quijano. Texas She's Got Legs (Ziva) Owned by Kirk and Terry Bomer, handled by Keith Gullede, scouted by Robbi Gullede were a pleasure to watch. Both dogs broke away to the front to have a divided find at 5. Both away to the front with Ziva scoring a nice find at 15, Lena with a find at 20, Ziva with a find at 22 with Lena backing, Ziva with a find 36, Lena with a find at 42, Ziva with a find at 48, Lena with a find at 50. All finds were to the front and the dogs flowed around the course with hard forward shooting dog race. This was a fun brace to watch as the bird work was

awesome. Ziva was named Champion and Lena was the Runner Up.

FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

PURPOSE:

To identify and honor those persons and dogs, both past and present, whose accomplishments in Field Trial Competition are exceptional, and whose contributions to the sport are outstanding.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

PEOPLE

1. The person must be at least 65 years old.
2. The person should have a significant record as a Field Trial competitor over a sustained period of time.
3. The person should have made a significant and sustained contribution to the sport by “giving back” through donation of time, resources and expertise, (for example: running trials, helping at trials, scribing, judging, providing grounds, encouraging and teaching newcomers, etc., etc.).
4. The person must have exhibited exceptional sportsmanship, integrity, and a history of unselfish giving to the sport.

DOGS

1. The dog must be deceased.
2. The dog must have a distinguished Field Trial record, especially in one hour Championships.
3. The dog must have a record of producing outstanding progeny, both as a competitors and as producers.

PROCESS OF SELECTION:

Nomination and selection occurs on an annual basis. The nominations open January 1 and close August 31 annually. Any individual may nominate dogs and/or persons. It is the responsibility of the nominating person to all relevant data with regard to the nominees’ accomplishments, which will support why that person or dog deserves to be considered for this award.

Nomination forms are available on the NGSPA website (www.ngspa.org) or from the Committee Chairman. Completed forms and supporting documentation must be received by the Chairman by the first of September (September 1) each year. If a nominee is not selected to enter “The Hall” in the year nominated, the nominee will remain eligible for consideration for two (2) additional years. Thus, a nomination is valid for three (3) years, at which time, it will expire if the nominee has not been selected into the Hall of Fame. Nominations will not be accepted for a nominee that fails to be selected in the first three year period until a minimum of three (3) years after the expiration of the first nomination.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Selection Committee is comprised of individuals who are selected for their experience, character and integrity in German Shorthaired Pointer field trials, and in breeding superior German Shorthaired Pointers. Their decision on the merits of nominees are independent and kept anonymous. Each year’s Honorees will be

announced no later than the first of December annually. Individuals elected to the selection committee will serve a 3 year term, and be eligible for one more consecutive second 3 year term.

INTRODUCTION:

Those selected will be formally inducted at ceremonies held at the Hall of Fame (Bird Dog Museum) in Grand Junction, Tennessee, on the Saturday before the beginning of the Pointer National Championship.

Committee members & their dog(s) are ineligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame during their service on the committee.

HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE STRUCTURAL GUIDELINES (These reflect past precedents)

- While the GSP Hall of Fame Selection Committee services at the pleasure of the NGSPA Board of Trustees, its decisions regarding inductees are to be totally independent of the board influence.
- It's operational procedures and membership are subject to the BOT approval.
- The maximum size of the committee is 15.

CHAIRMAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Chairman will be responsible to advise the Board of Committee resignations, and to present nominees to the Board for Approval.
- The Chairman will serve as the GSOP representative and present the inductees at the official induction ceremony.
- The Chairman will present proposed changes to procedures and processes to the BOT for approval.
- The Committee Chairman will provide a report at the annual BOT meeting.

FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

2020 NOMINATION FORM

Please note all nominations must be received no later than August 31 of the nomination year. (Nominations are good for three years).

In order to be nominated, dogs must be deceased. Persons may be nominated, living or dead; however, they must be at least 65 years of age, if still living.

FOR DOGS

In order to be considered, a resume that depicts a candidates complete field trial record in all types of field trial events, the candidate’s progeny and their quality. The dogs candidacy should be dependent on his entire competitive career, and the quality of his/her offspring.

FOR PERSONS

Persons to be nominated and selected into the GSP Field Trial Hall of Fame, need to have rendered outstanding service to the sport of field trialing, both at a local and national level for a long period of time. They need to have significant contributions that have made a measurable difference in the improvement to the sport of Field Trialing. Activities such as judging, being a club official, breeder, handler and/or a sustained record of breeding German Shorthaired Pointers which have contributed to the improvement of the GSP as a breed.

Because this is a great honor to bestow upon a person, the Election Committee needs an accurate and complete biography. Incorrect or misleading facts within the biography will cause the nomination to be denied until it is updated and corrected.
