NOTICE

NGSPA BOARD ACTION March 30, 2021 RE: COMPLAINT: April Raber vs. Joseph Amatulli

At its Annual Meeting on March 30, 2021, the Officers and Trustees of the National German Shorthaired Pointer Association, Inc. (The Board) met in Executive Session to hear the complaint made by April Raber against Joseph Amatulli.

The Board heard written and oral testimony from both parties and considered the written statement of one judge who was the only other witness, and the written finding of the Field Trial Chairman in support of the complainant's accusation of Conduct Unbecoming a Gentleman. During this phase of the hearing, Dan DiMambro, a Trustee with a close relationship to the accuser, was allowed to attend the hearing upon agreeing to provide moral support to April by his presence, but to remain silent during the hearing.

After the oral and written testimony was heard, the Board excused April Raber, Joseph Amatulli and Dan DiMambro, and conducted its deliberation.

The unanimous decision of the Board was to uphold the complaint that Joseph Amatulli had acted toward April Raber in a manner unbecoming a gentleman, and that he acted in a manner contrary to good sportsmanship and and detrimental to the best interests of field trials generally.

The Board approved banning Joseph Amatulli from holding any administrative capacity or leadership role (included but not limited to field trial chairman, club secretary, club treasurer or stake manager) in any NGSPA sanctioned event, including NGSPA dual sanctioned GSPCA events for a period of one year, commencing June 1, 2021 and ending May 31, 2022.

The Board approved placing Joseph Amatulli on probation during his one-year conditional ban and extending for another three years until May 31, 2025, during which any proven misconduct may result in a permanent ban from any participation in any NGSPA sanctioned event.

It was a very good stake with 5 clean and usable dogs with Championship quality runs. At the end of the day, We had two dogs that were the class of the field.

Brace #1 with BMB's Freeloder "Hewey" and Brace #10 with H's AM Cruiser "Cruiser". Hewey had a very nice forward race with 5 spaced finds. He handled nicely with style.

H's AM Cruiser "Cruiser" in Brace #10 showed a nice forward race with power and handled well. Cruiser had 3 spaced finds. There was a talk of a run-off between the two dogs for the Championship. But, with the lim tied time, we split hairs and awarded Hewey the Championship and Cruiser the Runner-up.

OPEN SHOOTING DOG

H's AM Cruiser "Cruiser" handled by Chase Verdoorn and Uodibar's Robbi Jo "Robbie Jo", handled by Keith Gullede, started off the afternoon on Course #1. They both took off well with Cruiser scoring his first find around the 15 minute mark. He displayed excellent style and intensity. Cruiser followed that up with 2 more finds before we headed North across the large open pasture. With strong head winds, he did want to go a little lateral, but eventually showed up to the front. Around that time, Robbi Jo was unfortunately seen under a wild pheasant rooster and ended her day. She was doing a really nice job. Cruiser continued on with another find at 50. He ran a nice shooting dog race and showed the same intensity and style on all his birds - never moving a muscle on any finds.

Unfortunately, Lena was up early after an extended flushing attempt and got the best of her. Sam started off needing some scouting, but after he reclaimed the front, the rest of the brace was a bird finding exhibition. He took his lines well and had several finds through the brace. All with great manners, intensity and style. After the brace, the Judges knew that they had something to talk about.

Of note - the judges also particularly liked Quijano's WD 40 "Rusty", handled by Josh Nieman and Texas She's Got Legs "Ziva" handled by Keith Gullede. Their performances were of high quality and could have won a Championship on any day. They were edged out this year, but needed to be recognized for their outstanding performances, as well.

DERBY CLASSIC

Uodibar's Lover Boy "Blue" handled by Keith Gullede, started in the first brace of the Derby and had us off to a good start. He ran the edges nicely, coming to check in every once in a while. He did a nice job in the big open pasture and was rewarded with a bird around 23 minutes. Great style and intensity on his bird. The handler knew there had to be a bird there and was correct. After the bird was flushed, Blue went on to finish the brace with plenty in reserve.

NK's Point The Way "Tallie" , handled by Keith Gullede, and Llano's Painted Lady "Lily", handled by Josh Nieman, both started off well. While both initially were going to the same places, as the course opened up and went on, they both started hunting hard and to the front independently. They both took the first fence line down to the end toward the road and crossed over into the large pasture with ease. In the page pasture, they both did a nice job, with Tallie slightly more independent. At 25 minutes, they were both found on a divided find, both with great style and manners on the birds.

FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

PURPOSE:

To identify and honor those persons and dogs, both past and present, whose accomplishments in Field Trial Competition are exceptional, and whose contributions to the sport are outstanding.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

PEOPLE

1. The person must be at least 65 years old.
2. The person should have a significant record as a Field Trial competitor over a sustained period of time.
3. The person should have made a significant and sustained contribution to the sport by “giving back” through donation of time, resources and expertise, (for example: running trials, helping at trials, scribing, judging, providing grounds, encouraging and teaching newcomers, etc., etc.).
4. The person must have exhibited exceptional sportsmanship, integrity, and a history of unselfish giving to the sport.

DOGS

1. The dog must be deceased.
2. The dog must have a distinguished Field Trial record, especially in one hour Championships.
3. The dog must have a record of producing outstanding progeny, both as a competitors and as producers.

PROCESS OF SELECTION:

Nomination and selection occurs on an annual basis. The nominations open January 1 and close August 31 annually. Any individual may nominate dogs and/or persons. It is the responsibility of the nominating person to all relevant data with regard to the nominees' accomplishments, which will support why that person or dog deserves to be considered for this award.

Nomination forms are available on the NGSPA website () or from the Committee Chairman. Completed forms and supporting documentation must be received by the Chairman by the first of September (September 1) each year. If a nominee is not selected to enter “The Hall” in the year nominated, the nominee will remain eligible for consideration for two (2) additional years. Thus, a nomination is valid for three (3) years, at which time, it will expire if the nominee has not been selected into the Hall of Fame. Nominations will not be accepted for a nominee that fails to be selected in the first three year period until a minimum of three (3) years after the expiration of the first nomination.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Selection Committee is comprised of individuals who are selected for their experience, character and integrity in German Shorthaired Pointer field trials, and in breeding superior German Shorthaired Pointers. Their decision on the merits of nominees are independent and kept anonymous. Each year's Honorees will be announced no later than the first of December annually. Individuals elected to the selection committee will serve a 3 year term, and be eligible for one more consecutive second 3 year term.

INTRODUCTION:

Those selected will be formally inducted at ceremonies held at the Hall of Fame (Bird Dog Museum) in Grand Junction, Tennessee, on the Saturday before the beginning of the Pointer National Championship.

Committee members & their dog(s) are ineligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame during their service on the committee.

HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE STRUCTURAL GUIDELINES (These reflect past precedents)

- While the GSP Hall of Fame Selection Committee serves at the pleasure of the NGSPA Board of Trustees, its decisions regarding inductees are to be totally independent of the board influence.
- Its operational procedures and membership are subject to the BOT approval.
- The maximum size of the committee is 15.

CHAIRMAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Chairman will be responsible to advise the Board of Committee resignations, and to present nominees to the Board for Approval.
- The Chairman will serve as the GSOP representative and present the inductees at the official induction ceremony.
- The Chairman will present proposed changes to procedures and processes to the BOT for approval.
- The Committee Chairman will provide a report at the annual BOT meeting.

FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

2021 NOMINATION FORM

Please note all nominations must be received no later than August 31 of the nomination year.
(Nominations are good for three years).

In order to be nominated, dogs must be deceased. Persons may be nominated, living or dead; however, they must be at least 65 years of age, if still living.

FOR DOGS

In order to be considered, a resume that depicts a candidates complete field trial record in all types of field trial events, the candidate's progeny and their quality. The dogs candidacy should be dependent on his entire competitive career, and the quality of his/her offspring.

FOR PERSONS

Persons to be nominated and selected into the GSP Field Trial Hall of Fame, need to have rendered outstanding service to the sport of field trialing, both at a local and national level for a long period of time. They need to have significant contributions that have made a measurable difference in the improvement to the sport of Field Trialing. Activities such as judging, being a club official, breeder, handler and/or a sustained record of breeding German Shorthaired Pointers which have contributed to the improvement of the GSP as a breed.

Because this is a great honor to bestow upon a person, the Election Committee needs an accurate and complete biography. Incorrect or misleading facts within the biography will cause the nomination to be denied until it is updated and corrected.
