NGSPA BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING June 2021

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP RELATED

National Championship Committee restructured to accommodate retirement of Dean Crabbs from the Committee Chairman position. We are excited to have Robin Lambourn step up to accept this important responsibility. The rest of the committee is all on board for another year.

We have strengthened the leadership of of Stakes Managers, and solidified this position for each stake.

We put together a strong roster of judge nominations. The judges will be contacted and the final roster put together as soon as possible.

Plan to improve Quail finds approved.

We plan to have scribes for each stake rather than relying on the judge's notes and the Stake Manager's write ups.

We have had many significant cost increases for many years without an increase in the entry fees for the National Championships and Futurity. The Trustees agonized over this issue and were faced with the decision of increasing our entry fees to cover our losses or keep on suffering losses until we run out of money, or substantially reduce cost and quality. We decided that we must make the responsible decision no matter how difficult and establish a scenario that will enable us to maintain the quality of our National Championships in a sustainable manner. Therefore, we will be increasing our entry fees by \$50.00 for each category, including the Futurity.

OTHER ITEMS OF INTEREST:

We have appointed two new Associate Trustees: Josh Nieman and Heath Autry.

Expect to see enhancements to our website before the end of the year. Most important will be a robust search of dog's information.

We approved new leadership plans for both Region 1 and Region 3.

NGSPA Region 9 Championships

After what was a non-existent spring trial season for the German Shorthair Pointer championship enthusiasts in 2020, most were eager to get back to this spring. This was evident by the extraordinary number of entries at our nationals and the number our competitors who made the trek to southern Idaho in mid-April to put their dogs to the test in the high desert. The grounds at the Prairie Wind Ranch were in great shape again this year, providing some big, rough, challenging terrain for dogs to hunt through. With a decent carryover of wild birds, as well as strategically released coveys of chukar, most of these canine athletes had ample opportunities to get game pointed. Keith and Bobbie Richardson, owners of the ranch, along with all of the fantastic help, ensure that the place is a first class venue. Rich Robertson along with Austin Williams make certain everything out on the three hour continuous courses are ready for man and beast. The staff in the clubhouse, Lynn, Kaitlyn, Anita, along with Rod and Linda Randolph kept food and drinks on the table and the place tidy after our daily gatherings. Dean Crabbs and his wife Diane had the dog wagon stocked with snacks and got dogs to the places needed to unleash the next brace. Club members Gary Moen and John Bunn were also present

Amateur Shooting Dog Championship

The Region 9 Amateur Shooting Dog championship is a special stake for those of us who attend this trial. A few years ago after the passing of Rick Dodge , a pillar of the region, as well as the NGSPA in whole, we decided to name

Derby Classic

Open All-Age Championship

The open all age championships in the GSP world seem to be gaining numbers in most areas of the country, out west being no different. Seventeen canine athletes were drawn to contest this championship. This stake was run under the watchful eyes of Larry McConnell, who now calls New Plymouth, ID home, and Mike Eades from Ephrata, WA. After these dogs finished "eating up" most of this big country, champion honors were awarded to Prairie Wind BDK's Dot On The Horizon. "Dot" is owned by Keith and Bobbi Richardson and was handled by Rich Robertson. Another fantastic performance was turned in by AO Tripps To Win, owned by Alan Davison. Josh Nieman handled "Tripp" to the runner up spot in the stake.

Open Shooting Dog Championship

The open shooting dog stake was the final stake for the Region 9 event. Brandon Blum from CO graciously stepped up to judge at the last minute and rode alongside judging partner, Howard Burbach, who made the trek from Pleasant Hill, MO. After nineteen dogs were turned loose from their respective starting points, a couple of performances definitely rose to the top. FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

PURPOSE:

To identify and honor those persons and dogs, both past and present, whose accomplishments in Field Trial Competition are exceptional, and whose contributions to the sport are outstanding.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

PEOPLE

1. The person must be at least 65 years old.
2. The person should have a significant record as a Field Trial competitor over a sustained period of time.
3. The person should have made a significant and sustained contribution to the sport by “giving back” through donation of time, resources and expertise, (for example: running trials, helping at trials, scribing, judging, providing grounds, encouraging and teaching newcomers, etc., etc.).
4. The person must have exhibited exceptional sportsmanship, integrity, and a history of unselfish giving to the sport.

DOGS

1. The dog must be deceased.
2. The dog must have a distinguished Field Trial record, especially in one hour Championships.
3. The dog must have a record of producing outstanding progeny, both as a competitors and as producers.

PROCESS OF SELECTION:

Nomination and selection occurs on an annual basis. The nominations open January 1 and close August 31 annually. Any individual may nominate dogs and/or persons. It is the responsibility of the nominating person to all relevant data with regard to the nominees’ accomplishments, which will support why that person or dog deserves to be considered for this award.

Nomination forms are available on the NGSPA website () or from the Committee Chairman. Completed forms and supporting documentation must be received by the Chairman by the first of September (September 1) each year. If a nominee is not selected to enter “The Hall” in the year nominated, the nominee will remain eligible for consideration for two (2) additional years. Thus, a nomination is valid for three (3) years, at which time, it will expire if the nominee has not been selected into the Hall of Fame. Nominations will not be accepted for a nominee that fails to be selected in the first three year period until a minimum of three (3) years after the expiration of the first nomination.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Selection Committee is comprised of individuals who are selected for their experience, character and integrity in German Shorthaired Pointer field trials, and in breeding superior German Shorthaired

Pointers. Their decision on the merits of nominees are independent and kept anonymous. Each year's Honorees will be announced no later than the first of December annually. Individuals elected to the selection committee will serve a 3 year term, and be eligible for one more consecutive second 3 year term.

INTRODUCTION:

Those selected will be formally inducted at ceremonies held at the Hall of Fame (Bird Dog Museum) in Grand Junction, Tennessee, on the Saturday before the beginning of the Pointer National Championship.

Committee members & their dog(s) are ineligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame during their service on the committee.

HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE STRUCTURAL GUIDELINES (These reflect past precedents)

- While the GSP Hall of Fame Selection Committee services at the pleasure of the NGSPA Board of Trustees, its decisions regarding inductees are to be totally independent of the board influence.
- It's operational procedures and membership are subject to the BOT approval.
- The maximum size of the committee is 15.

CHAIRMAN RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Chairman will be responsible to advise the Board of Committee resignations, and to present nominees to the Board for Approval.
- The Chairman will serve as the GSOP representative and present the inductees at the official induction ceremony.

FIELD TRIAL HALL OF FAME

2021 NOMINATION FORM

Please note all nominations must be received no later than August 31 of the nomination year.
(Nominations are good for three years).

In order to be nominated, dogs must be deceased. Persons may be nominated, living or dead; however, they must be at least 65 years of age, if still living.

FOR DOGS

In order to be considered, a resume that depicts a candidates complete field trial record in all types of field trial events, the candidate's progeny and their quality. The dogs candidacy should be dependent on his entire competitive career, and the quality of his/her offspring.

FOR PERSONS

Persons to be nominated and selected into the GSP Field Trial Hall of Fame, need to have rendered outstanding service to the sport of field trialing, both at a local and national level for a long period of time. They need to have significant contributions that have made a measurable difference in the improvement to the sport of Field Trialing. Activities such as judging, being a club official, breeder, handler and/or a sustained record of breeding German Shorthaired Pointers which have contributed to the improvement of the GSP as a breed.

Because this is a great honor to bestow upon a person, the Election Committee needs an accurate and complete biography. Incorrect or misleading facts within the biography will cause the nomination to be denied until it is updated and corrected.
